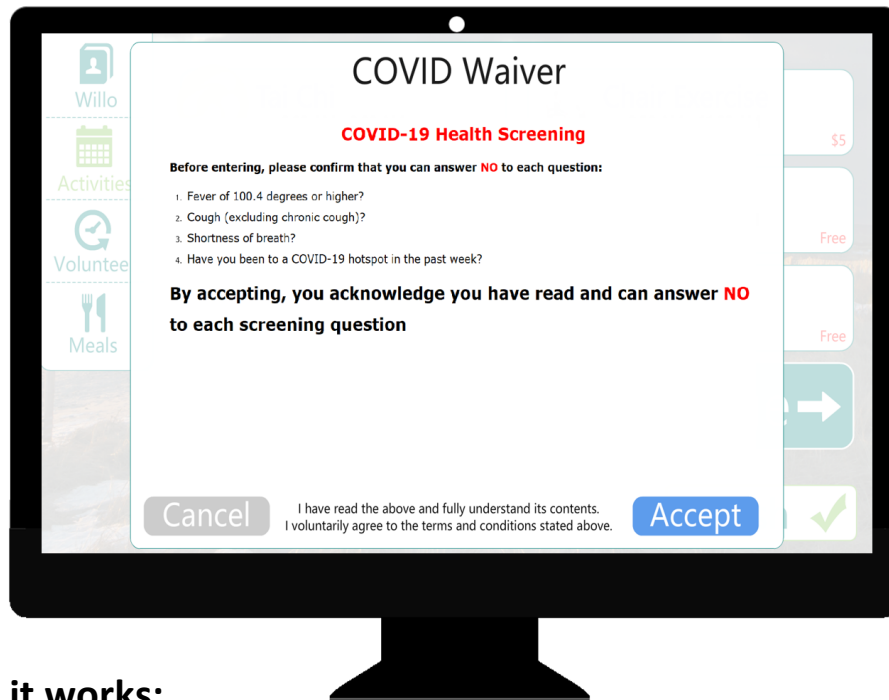


Touchscreen Waivers and Cleaning Process

You will likely have entrance and participation rules when your building reopens – even if it's to a limited audience. We have a new feature you can use to present your daily COVID rules or waiver for acceptance, right on the touchscreen.



Here's how it works:

- Through the 'People' section, click on 'Contracts'
- Enter your Waiver and use the formatting tools to change colors or font sizes
- Set the 'Require type' field to 'On Kiosk Sign in' and select 'End of Day' for Expiring
- The next time a person scans in at the screen, they will see the waiver and have to accept it before they can check-in for the activities

Cleaning the screen

Even though touch is not a major contributor to spreading COVID, you should have everyone sanitize their hands before and/or after using the screen (at least you know their hands will be clean for a little while...). Cleaning the screen with any kind of liquid will destroy the computer. On occasion, you can clean the screen by putting a dab of hand sanitizer (smaller than a pea) on a microfiber cloth and wiping gently from side to side, top to bottom when the screen is off.
